Haverhill, MA - Anthony M Picucci, 92, formerly of Leominster, MA, passed away on Thursday November 7, 2013 after a long illness. He was born in Leominster, the son of the late Joseph and Concetta (Lombardy) Picucci.

Anthony grew up in Leominster and graduated from Cushing Academy. He attended Holy Cross College in Worcester, MA and the University of Louisiana. He entered into the United States Coast Guard on October 8, 1942 and served as a reserve active duty until November 16, 1945. During that time he earned the rating of Seaman First Class. He served aboard the LST 71 in the South Pacific during WW II as a driver and gunner. Anthony went on to work for the Federal Government at Fort Devens outfitting troops for thirty-five years. After retirement, he worked for the City of Leominster as a weigher at the transfer station.
